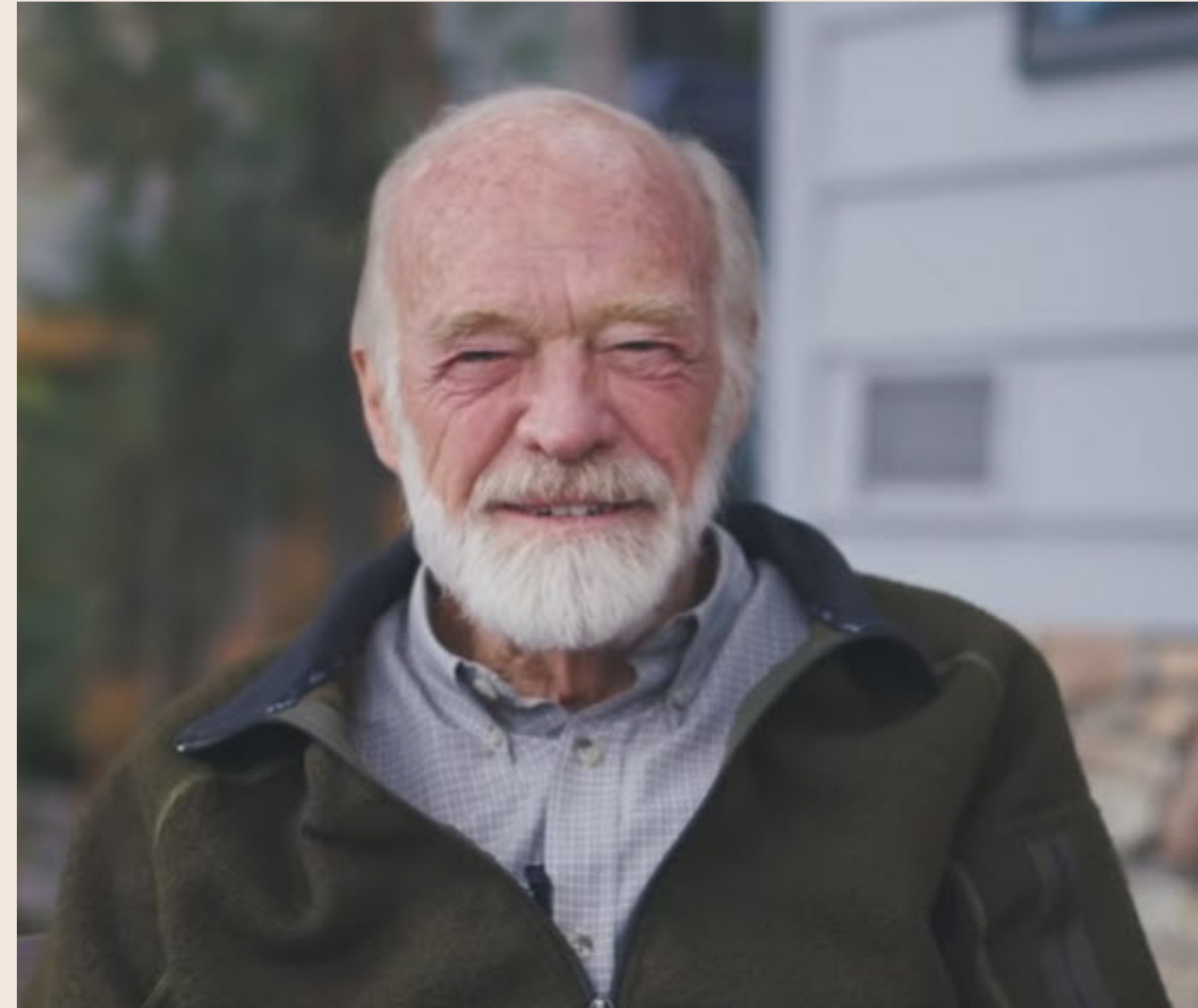
SERVANT

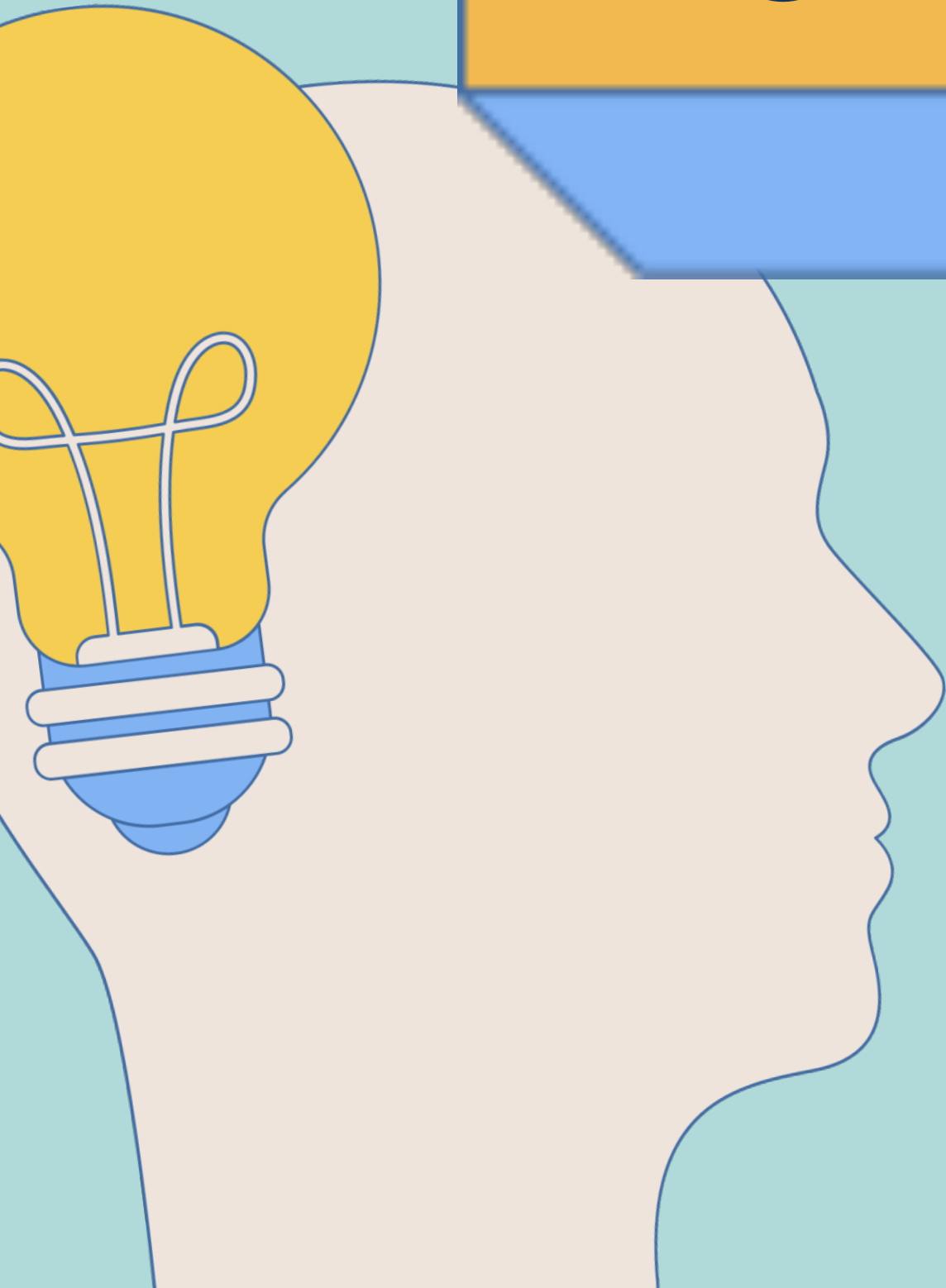
